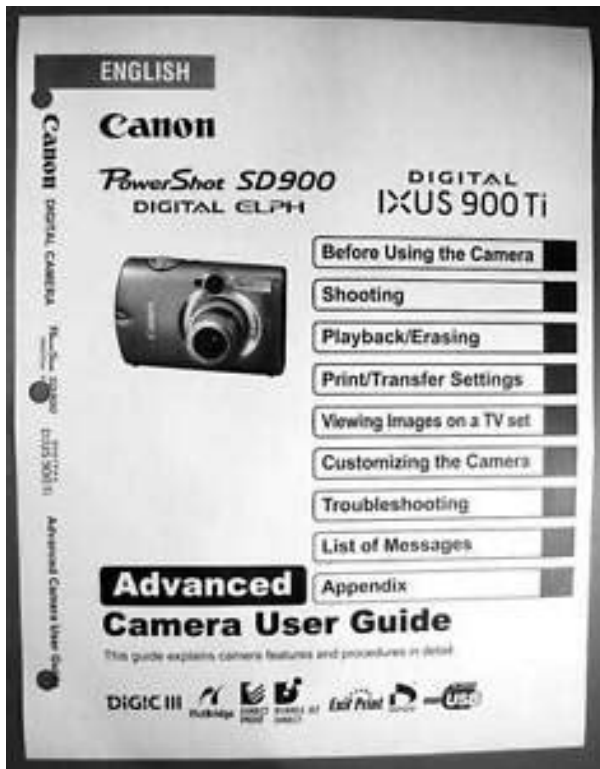

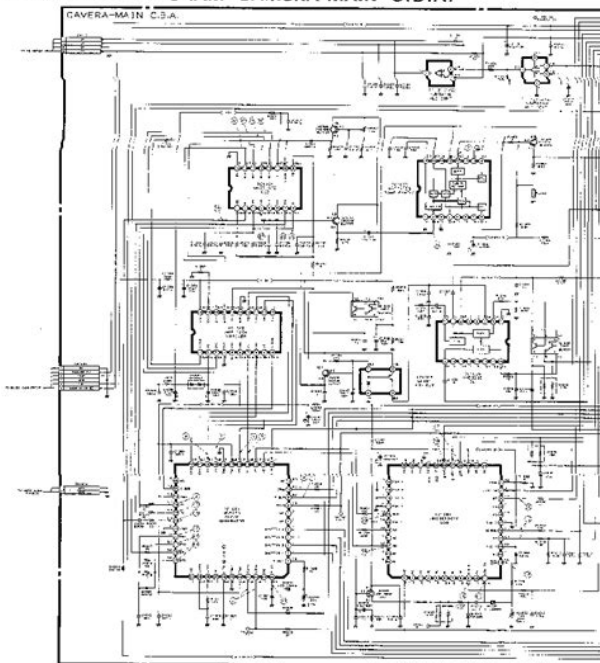

Magarity Top Contributor Photography 5.0 out of 5 stars This flash has about as much reach as a pop up flash but unlike the pop up you can swivel it or use as a slave. Even then, this connection only tells the flash when to fire. There is no TTL Through The Lens metering. In S1 and S2 mode, this flash will only fire in sync with your oncamera flash. There is no guide number or sync speed listed, but from my tests it is quite powerful. The power, together with the ability to remote fire, rotate, bounce and diffuse the flash is a great upgrade over any builtin flash. Included stand has a tripod mount which is very useful. Optical trigger is very sensitive and has a wide catchment area, meaning the flash does not have to be lineofsight with the flash on your camera to trigger.

You can turn down your oncamera flash or diffuse it heavily and this unit will still fire. The only downside to this unit is its lack of TTL metering meaning it has to be manually adjusted and radio wireless control meaning you have to fire your oncamera flash to trigger it remotely. However no flash at this price point has those features. This is unbeatable for the money. For the money, there is

nothing remotely close to this thing. The construction is solid, it has nice features like flash intensity and unlike some other brands, the manual is coherent. I really love the swivel flash head side to side and up and down. I may buy another to use as a slave. Yes, it requires batteries, but at this price, who cares. BTW, I use mine with a Canon 5D Mark II. However, 2 of the 3 units stopped functioning after less than 6 months. The issue is that on repeated use multiple flashes during a photography shoot, the units get quite warm and this causes battery acid to leech from the battery onto the battery cover. This leaves residual acid on the cover over time and disrupts the connection between the battery and the leads on the cover. Once you become aware of the issue, you can check for it to clean them off, but if you don't know about it, you won't ever open the battery cover and you won't know that this is an issue until the unit stops working. So, if you are using these as a flash option for studio photography and will have the units flashing multiple times in a row, these are probably not the best units for that. If you are using these as a simply flash photography support for an event or a family gathering, then they should work better because the units won't get so warm and cause the battery acid leakage issue. One further note, I used multiple battery types in the units so I don't think that it was a battery issue, but that this is an issue with the units themselves. Sometimes steps are half of the previous and sometimes not.

I was given a refund and will not be purchasing again. Within two minutes of turning it on I heard a loud pop from inside the flash followed by a buzzing sound. Then liquid started leaking out of the battery compartment. At first I thought a battery fresh RayOvacs had exploded. Removing the batteries, they all looked intact with no signs of physical damage. I later confirmed they were all good with a volt meter. What really happened was evident. One of the internal electrolytic capacitors, possibly the one storing the charge for the flash, had exploded and leaked electrolyte. Absolutely cannot recommend this product. Returned for credit. The next day this baby arrived in the post along with 4 Ninjago collectors wallets, 2 novelty desk lamps, a Gluten free cookbook written by Bez and a signed Les Dennis Autobiography. She said it gives off great light and improved her photos massively and just worked with the click of the button straight out the box. Meanwhile I got to visit the local 50 station and start some community service. Sorry, we failed to record your vote. Please try again I bought two of these for offcamera use only. With that being said, I decided to mess around with it briefly oncamera, and it is terrible compared to my proper Nikon SB900. I'm not sure if it's a syncing issue or what, and in truth I didn't experiment with it very much, but in all testshots taken at the time, the lower third of the frame was always substantially dark while the top two-thirds was fine. For this reason, I would not recommend this for use as an oncamera flash. Now that that's out of the way, I am using them as offcamera flashes, and for this purpose they do a very good job. If you need faster shutter times, you'll need a better product that can deal with highspeed syncing. In most cases I am using S2 mode when indoors, and for outdoors I use Neewer wireless remote triggers and the flash is in M mode.

These flashes work well when you intentionally position them and consider available lighting and the power setting you wish to use. The fact that the instructions state that you shouldn't trigger the flash at highpower more than 100 times per hour equaling once every 36 seconds, unless my math is bad lol isn't realistic for a photographer, nor does it instill confidence, however I have exceeded this limit without any adverse effects. I should note that during the very first time I used these outdoors at maximum brightness for a few hours on an incredibly hot day, one of them stopped working it still appeared to power on, but would not trigger or respond to the TEST button. I have experimented with using them on tripods, and by standing them on the ground with their supplied stand, plus I've also angled them to a desired angle and then laid them down directly on the ground. In one instance, I was shooting pictures under overcast skies well into the evening, and these flashes allowed it to

legitimately seem as though the sun was still up and bright that day. Im always nervous that theyll die prematurely since they are so cheap, but so far they are working out, and Im getting good results. The battery flap feels cheap and makes me slightly nervous every time I open it, but overall the product doesnt show any signs of breaking yet. These flashes do not have TTL through the lens, so its all manual, meaning youll need to experiment. Aside from the scare of it stopping working during that first shoot but then started working again two days later, its been smooth sailing ever since, and Im content with my decision to buy two of these. Sorry, we failed to record your vote. Please try again Would buy again and I recommend it to other photographers who are looking for something that is lightweight and affordable. Edit Received on May 22nd. Dead on June 18th, after only using it twice.

The first time was pretty lightweight, only used for a partial night of live music venue shots on June 16/17. The second night, June 17/18, about 5 hours of use, a lot of photos, but enough time between shots to recharge the flash. By the end of the shoot, it was overheated and now completely dead. Not overly impressed, and no longer stand by my initial review. Sorry, we failed to record your vote. Please try again These flashes make it possible for me to put radio triggers on one and have that flash sync the rest of them. Works every time. Im using them in studio or studioliike settings, which is a distinction that needs to be made as they do feel a bit flimsy for event or wedding photography. Using them in a stable environment on lightstands or the included plastic stand works perfectly. Another reviewer suggested that the fact that these are branded as Amazon Basics right on the front of the camera might make you look less professional. I have two answers to this 1. We call those people Uncle Bob for a reason. 2. If it bothers you enough, a Sharpie can fix it for you. I cant stress enough how great these are for cheap studio strobes. Just keep shooting!
